## RE: Request for Finding of Eligibility to Seek Compensation Submitted by Consumer Federation of California Education Foundation

Please be advised that Consumer Federation of California Education Foundation ("Requester") has submitted a Request for Finding of Eligibility to Seek Compensation ("Request") pursuant to section 2662.2 of Title 10 of the California Code of Regulations, a copy of which can be found on the <u>Department of Insurance's website</u>. Requester asserts it represents the interest of consumers and on those grounds seeks a finding that it is eligible to seek compensation in Department of Insurance proceedings pursuant to Insurance Code section 1861.10.

Insurance Code section 1861.10 requires all Requests for Eligibility to be published on the Department of Insurance website. Similar to publicly accessible information regarding insurance companies, information regarding intervenors is important to ensure that all participants in the rate application process are complying with applicable statutes and regulations. If you wish to comment on the pending Request for Eligibility, you must let the Department know your desire to be heard by **Wednesday**, **June 28**, **2024**. Thereafter, the Department will provide a schedule for the submission of such comments and allow responses from the Requester.

The subject matter upon which interested parties may provide comment includes without limitation:

- Whether or not Requester represents the interest of consumers.
- Whether or not Requester has met the standards set forth in 10 CCR section 2662.2 for establishing an intervenor or participant represents the interests of consumers.
- Whether any additional information would aid the Commissioner in determining whether or not Requester represents the interests of consumers.
- Whether the Request is complete per 10 CCR section 2662.2(a)(2)(A)-(G).
